**Re: Credit Transfer Agreement between Australian Catholic University and Melbourne Rudolf Steiner Seminar**

I am writing in response to your requested application for a Credit Transfer Agreement (**Agreement**) pathway from the Melbourne Rudolf Steiner Seminar course **Advanced Diploma in Rudolph Steiner Education** into the **Bachelor of Education** programs offered by the Faculty of Education and Arts at Australian Catholic University (**ACU**).

ACU extends to the Rudolf Steiner Seminar the following credit:

ACU reserves the right to specify the course components required for course completion regarding both course content and graduate attributes. ACU also reserves the right to amend, alter, update or discontinue any aspect of the course components upon giving reasonable notice to Melbourne Rudolf Steiner Seminar.

This Agreement will apply from **01 January 2021 to 31 December 2024 (Term)** unless it is otherwise updated or replaced with a new agreement. Either party may terminate this Agreement during the term upon providing written notice of 6 months to the other Party. In the event that the Agreement is terminated by either Party, students who have commenced their study at ACU prior to notification of termination of this Agreement will be permitted to complete the award in which they are enrolled.

As part of this credit transfer agreement, students who successfully complete the Melbourne Rudolf Steiner Seminar specified course will need to apply to ACU via the relevant Tertiary Admissions Centre. If their application is successful, students will receive the specified credit.

As a condition of enrolment at ACU, all Melbourne Rudolf Steiner Seminar students will be required to take the **ACU Core curriculum** as part of their ACU program of study.

Students will be required to Choose ONE unit from:

- UNCC100: Self and Community: Exploring the Anatomy of Modern Society
- PHCC102: Being Human
- PHCC104: Ethics and the Good Life

and ONE unit from:

- UNCC300: Justice and Change in a Global World
- PHCC320: The Just Society

As part of this association, Melbourne Rudolf Steiner Seminar is welcome (and, indeed, encouraged) to display ACU's official logo and information pertaining to this Agreement on its web page and in official marketing material during the period of the Agreement. Any public use of ACU's official logo and reference to ACU, however, must be approved by the Office of Academic Partnerships prior to any such display.

It is important that Melbourne Rudolf Steiner Seminar advises ACU of any changes to its status as an RTO or significant changes to the National Training Package or RTO course.
